A sublime Flemish cabinet in ebonized wood and marquetry, dating from the 17th century, resting on twisted legs joined by an X-shaped stretcher. This last door reveals three more small drawers. The doors are richly decorated with scenes of mythological inspiration. The sides feature a decoration of flowering vases within a guilloché ebonized wood frame. The frieze is finely engraved with an animal motif. The molded cornice has a frieze of scrolling foliage. The interior boasts a sophisticated composition of multiple marquetry drawers framing a... Central niche. Includes a key. A very fine piece of furniture, crafted with
