An elegant French biscuit sculpture from the late 19th century, signed "Falconet," depicting a young, nude female figure captured in a moment of intimate naturalness. The girl, in a graceful, slightly bent pose, holds a soft drape that flows down her leg, creating a refined contrast between the smoothness of her skin and the fluid movement of the drape. Crafted in biscuit--unglazed porcelain with a distinctive matte, velvety finish--the work stands out for its pure white color and the quality of its modeling, which highlights meticulous attention to anatomical details, the delicate lines of the face, and the naturalistic rendering of the fabrics.
