Description

The artist Werner Schreib has a special historical connection with Göttingen, particularly through his significant exhibitions in the 1960s. Support: panel. Signature: incised and fired in the lower right corner of the composition and countersigned and fired on the back. Note: on the back, the address where the artist was supposed to have lived in Göttingen. Title: French translation of the German title: Labyrinth. Technique: collage of German newspapers and mixed media on panel.

** Werner Schreib is famous for inventing the "sealing" process, a printing technique using seals and stamps, as well as for his "semantic pictures" (Semantische Bilder) which explore the structures of visual language. International recognition: In 1966, he was the first German artist to receive the Polish "Ex Aequo Prize". He also represented
