Restauration Period Ring (circa 1820-1830) - Peridot and 18k GoldAn 18k yellow gold ring featuring a bezel-set oval peridot, surrounded by delicate seed pearls and scrolling filigree gold wire. The shoulders are adorned with small gold flowers that taper into a fine border along the hoop. Period: French Restauration (circa 1820-1830). Details: Ring Size: 55 (resizable). Weight: 2.1 g (18k gold - 750/1000 - "Owl" hallmark). Markings: Features an internal "PR 18" cartouche. Condition: Having survived nearly two centuries, this ring remains in beautifully fresh condition. To be noted: a slight break in one of the filigree scrolls and fine abrasions on the facets of the peridot. These signs of wear are a testament to its age and do not compromise the structural integrity of the mount.
