With concave sides and a drawer in the frieze, it is topped with a beautiful white marble slab veined with gray, bordered by a gallery of gilt brass and openwork. Its fluted uprights are joined by a stretcher shelf also bordered by a gallery of gilt brass and openwork. The sides and drawers are highlighted with moldings and beaded friezes. The console features beautiful and rich ornamentation in bronze and gilt brass, including the gallery, scrapers, side and drawer framing, keyhole escutcheon, and drawer pulls.
