Porcelain Teapot - Empire Period, early 19th century. An elegant white porcelain teapot decorated in grisaille with allegorical scenes inspired by Love. Each side features an oval medallion framed by a wide gold border, depicting neoclassical scenes accompanied by the inscriptions: "I want to spare you another crime" and "Beauty disarms sleeping Love." The mount is richly highlighted with broad areas of gilding: neck, foot, spout, and handle. The spout terminates in a stylized feline head, typical of the Empire style, reminiscent of antique models. The proportions are harmonious, with an ovoid body resting on a pronounced foot, characteristic of the first third of the 19th century. Good overall condition. Wear consistent with age to the gilding, particularly on the foot and neck. French
