Landscape of the banks of the Seine in the 19th century at Bas Meudon, in Issy-les-Moulineaux, near Paris. Henri Julien Detouche, born in Paris on January 10, 1854, and died in the same city on March 12, 1913, was a French painter, draftsman, watercolorist, engraver, lithographer, writer, and art critic. Our watercolor of the banks of the Seine is similar to another watercolor (perhaps this one?) exhibited at the Salon des Artistes Français in 1886 in Paris, at the Palais des Champs-Élysées, under number 2760.
