Thorn Reliquary of the Holy Crown of Christ - Filigree Silver - 18th Century - Italy. Authentic and remarkable circular reliquary in filigree silver, forming a rosette with eight radiating lobes, entirely composed of hand-crafted scrolls and twisted volutes. The work is of great finesse, typical of 18th-century Mediterranean or Iberian production. Description: At the center, a relic identified as: "Spina DNJC" (Spina Domini Nostri Jesu Christi - Thorn of Our Lord Jesus Christ). The thorn is placed on a red textile background, framed by gilded paper filigree forming a radiating decoration, according to the Baroque tradition of Passion reliquaries. The whole is carefully mounted in a circular silver lunette. On the reverse: Intact closure with red silk threads - Well-preserved ancient

Condition: Very good overall condition. - Even antique patina on the filigree - Normal surface oxidation for its age - Antique wax seal with age-related wear but complete.
