- Horizontal needlepoint tapestry, English work from the early 20th century - This needlework offers a charming decoration through a vibrant display of colors and motifs inspired by nature. Numerous plants unfold and repeat endlessly: flowering stems, floral scrolls, foliage, and bunches of grapes pecked at by birds. These are complemented by antique-style vases from which bouquets of flowers stand. The decorative qualities of this tapestry are appreciated in the composition, which develops a skillful blend of rounded shapes and lines, in the fresh colors, and in the interplay of contrasts (each motif is outlined with a dark line). - Needlepoint tapestry technique.
