This elegant Louis XVI style two-tier side table beautifully captures the refined neoclassical aesthetic of the late 19th century. The rectangular top is inset with a striking onyx panel, displaying natural veining in soft ivory, honey, and caramel tones. Each stone surface is unique, and here the organic patterns create a painterly effect that contrasts beautifully with the crisp geometry of the gilt bronze gallery. A pierced, lattice-patterned ormolu railing surrounds the top, adding both protection and architectural refinement. The frieze is adorned with scrolling gilt bronze motifs framed by delicately detailed rosettes at each
