Modernist solid elm shelving unit by Pierre Chapo, produced by the Seltz factory in the 1950s. Pierre Chapo, a French architect and cabinetmaker trained at the École des Beaux-Arts, established himself in the 1950s-1970s as one of the leading names in modern furniture. Inspired by the principles of the Bauhaus and the creations of Charlotte Perriand and Le Corbusier, he developed his own rigorous style, where structure, function, and material are central to his designs. His preferred material was solid elm, which he worked with great craftsmanship, emphasizing traditional joinery techniques. This shelving unit perfectly illustrates Chapo's aesthetic. Its clean, solid design highlights the beauty of the wood, while the strong side supports visually anchor the whole. The shelves
