Description

Art Deco oak and wrought-iron sideboard by Léon and Maurice Jallot (1940s). An exceptional sideboard that pairs with the table (reference 2094). Its perfectly symmetrical, architectural composition rests on two bold rectangular supports joined by a wide base. The front features two elaborately crafted doors adorned with carved panels displaying geometric relief patterns. At the center, a spectacular wrought-iron scrollwork element provides a graphic contrast and highlights the piece's decorative character. Its generous proportions, deeply molded framing, and the combination of light oak with patinated metal showcase exquisite craftsmanship. This creation blends Art Deco precision with a more architectural, neo-rustic aesthetic--a hallmark of leading French decorators of the interwar period.

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
