The Art Deco period extended from 1910 to 1939, it is characterized by a taste for symmetry, sophisticated geometry. In its center, one can see in bas-relief the basilica of Lourdes, the cave where the Virgin would have appeared to Saint Bernadette, and Saint Bernadette kneeling.
