Woven and knotted wool on wool in the traditional manner, the quality of the wool is absolutely remarkable, almost silky. The pile is short, a distinctive feature of antique Caucasian rugs. The piece is supple and lightweight structurally, yet it maintains good stability on the floor. It features three distinct medallions within a central madder red field. The motifs include stylized dragons, stars, various cruciform patterns, and amulets. Multiple borders feature floral motifs. The colors range from deep indigo blue and madder red to walnut, ivory, saffron yellow, and olive green. Of rare beauty, this piece can illuminate an entire space.
