The surface shows natural variations in ochre and sienna with visible throwing lines and kiln marks. Age-related patina and wear consistent with use enhance its authenticity and historic character. Artist Unknown artisan, Mediterranean region, 19th century. Artist Details Produced by a regional potter within the traditional ceramic workshops of Mediterranean olive-growing communities.
