



Sculpture Of Saint Eligius, 1480-1500



Description

Representation of St. Eligius, patron saint of all blacksmiths, with his attributes of the hammer and the horse's leg. Legend has it that he removed the entire leg of a stubborn horse in order to shoe it and then reattached it. Remains of the old polychrome setting; passed over in places. Carved conifer wood, hollowed at the back.
