## Important Ceremonial Pewter Platter With Coat Of Arms - Engraved Wedding Ring, Late 17th Century

### Description

A large circular pewter dish with a wide, molded rim, decorated in its center with a rich engraved design representing a coat of arms cartouche surmounted by a noble crown. The central medallion is framed by foliate scrolls and volutes of an elegant design, characteristic of the late 17th century. The shield is engraved with initials arranged in three registers: AIM:C\*G:LIM, accompanied by two intertwined hearts, suggesting a family or marital alliance, a common practice for ceremonial pewter dishes intended for social display. The reverse bears a hallmark dated 1691, consistent with the typology and quality of the object. The rim of the dish is heavily corroded on the right. This type of dish was intended to be displayed on a sideboard or presented on important occasions, reflecting the
