




China, Republic, Bowl With Lotus Decoration

Bowl with a post frieze and lotus scroll decoration. Glazed porcelain with black highlights. China, apocryphal Daoguang mark (1820-1850). Republic period (1912-1949). Dimensions: Diameter 17 cm. Condition report: excellent condition, some minor firing flaws. Our bowl features an elegant lotus decoration, glazed in green overglaze. This type of decoration, with green glaze on a white background, originated during the first decades of the 15th century under the reign of the Yongle Emperor. This bowl, although its mark is apocryphal, is a piece of very high quality: the body, immaculately white, produces a delightful crystalline resonance when
