Religious statue of the Virgin Mary or Our Lady of Good Help regulates the 19th century, this devotional statue represents the crowned Virgin Mary, arms outstretched, open, protecting young children representing believers. These statues of devotions were sold by the parishioners to provide for the church, for the pilgrims visiting. She symbolizes the merciful Virgin who welcomes the members of the faith to join her in her purity and obedience to the faith. This representation is that of 'Our Lady of Good Help', referring to the famous figure of the Virgin Mary and her human nature, popular in holy & orthodox iconography of the 14th century. The beauty of this craft is found in a miniaturized and qualitative version of the Virgin crowned by the
