This charming portrait of a child, dating from the late 18th to early 19th century, is a realistic work in monochrome, depicting an attentive young child in the style of the Greuze school. This lovely painting is a spontaneous and expressive work, quickly brushed and remarkably effective. Shown in three-quarter view, the child's gaze is disciplined and attentive, and the wide-eyed expression is striking. The ruffled, scalloped collar of the bodice beautifully accentuates this youthful face with its milky skin and rosy cheeks. A charming study and painting in light tones, this quality pastel is well presented in good original condition, reflecting the style of the many studies by the Painter of Tournus...
