Pair of Rococo-Style Candelabra

France, 20th Century

An elegant pair of Rococo-style candelabra crafted from a copper alloy with a predominantly brass finish, gilt and subtly patinated in blue-green tones.

The decoration draws directly from the Louis XV ornamental vocabulary: sinuous curves, vegetal scrolls, acanthus leaves, and stylized floral motifs. Each candelabrum features three candle arms emerging from a central undulating shaft, all resting on a richly ornamented, shaped base.

The interplay between the warm gilt surface and the nuanced blue-green patina creates a refined decorative contrast, characteristic of the historicist reinterpretations popular throughout the 20th century.
