Description

Atmospheric oil on canvas depicting a Venetian lagoon view at sunset, painted by Umberto Levi and signed lower left, dating to the second half of the 20th century. The scene represents the historic area of Cava Zuccherina (now Eraclea, near Jesolo), capturing the quiet poetry typical of Venetian lagoon landscapes. The composition balances waterfront buildings, moored boats, and shimmering reflections, rendered in a soft, luminous palette of warm, muted tones. Levi's brushwork is expressive yet controlled, with particular sensitivity to light and water reflections, as well as the subtle tonal transitions of the evening sky, giving the painting a calm and contemplative mood.
