An elegant pair of polychrome porcelain figurines depicting cavalrymen from the Napoleonic era, finely detailed and richly decorated. Each figurine features an officer mounted on a rearing horse, resting on a rectangular base with gilt relief decoration: One titled "GARDE IMPERIALE" (Imperial Guard), depicting a mounted drummer. The other titled "A. CHEVAL" / "BESSIÈRES" (A. Horse) represents a senior officer in a green and gold uniform. The horses are rendered dynamically (with their forelegs raised), and the uniforms are enhanced with gilding and vibrant colors (green, red, gold, purple).
