- Two forks and a spoon - Hammered and engraved silver - By Joseph Dulaurier: received as master silversmith in Pau in 1778 - Pau (France), 1778-1785 - Length: 20 cm; weight: 79g, 80g (forks), 73g (spoon), totaling 232g - Fork tines slightly worn, bowl slightly worn, beautiful patina - Provenance: private collection - Set of two forks and a plain spoon. The two forks have the tines engraved with a monogram "BC" surmounted by a wreath of flowers (18th century), forming a set with the spoons bearing the same hallmarks and pattern without a monogram. - Hallmarks (on the handle): silversmith: ID with three crowned grains of remedy for Joseph Dulaurier received as master silversmith in Pau in 1778 [Helft, no. 764d]; Identification mark (?): a cow, Pau, circa
