Description

Gothic Bronze Candlestick - Southern Netherlands, Late 15th Century. A rare and elegant bronze candlestick, originating from the former Low Countries and dating from the late 15th century. This piece is characterized by a slender stem adorned with successive knobs (buttons), typical of the production of workshops in the Low Countries during the late Middle Ages. The cylindrical socket has a rectangular opening to facilitate the removal of wax or to adjust the candle. It rests on a flared and stable base, composed of a circular plate surmounting a truncated conical foot, ensuring balance and elegance. The harmonious silhouette, the simplicity of the decoration, and the beautiful antique patina attest to a late Gothic production, both functional and refined. This type of
