

Antique painting by Eugène Galien Laloue (1854-1941): The Banks of the Seine. Signed with his pseudonym "E Galiany" in the lower right corner. Beautiful light and a very fine classical brushstroke by this artist. Sold in its original frame in very good condition. Frame dimensions: 71 cm x 53.5 cm. Painting dimensions: 55 cm x 38 cm. Good condition. A very small stain in the upper left corner without any impact on the work. About: Eugène Galien-Laloue, a painter of the early 20th century, famous for his gouache and oil views of Paris. He painted under various pseudonyms: Dupuy, Galiany, Juliani, and Lievin, but also Kermainguy, Lenoir, and Michel, thus avoiding the exclusive contracts that bound him. The painter is listed in the "Bénézit" dictionary, etc.
