Among these is a monogram in which the letters R and V intertwine, surmounted by a count's coronet composed of nine pearls on a gold circle adorned with embroidered rubies and emeralds. Meticulous and delicate silk thread embroidery with geometric and floral patterns elegantly frames the cushion like a border. With great attention to detail, the edge is further embellished with polychrome silk cord trim. - Some wear and losses are present in the embroidery and appliqués. - Dimensions: Thickness: 15.5 cm, Width: 45.5 cm, Height: 44 cm
