Description

Here is a painting depicting a view of the Church of Saint-Leu in Amiens in 1937. This oil painting presents a picturesque view of the historic district with its church. The church appears as the central figure of the painting, surrounded by the rooftops. The bell tower is recognizable above the ochre and brick-colored houses. This composition is distinguished by a Post-Impressionist style. The particularly generous application of paint, using dense brushstrokes, contributes to the structuring of the forms. This impasto technique does not simply define the architecture of the Church of Saint-Leu and the surrounding houses; it brings a true character to the scene by playing with light. The monogram "VH" is visible on the painting - its identification remains to be determined. It is an oil on panel, sold in its original
