This remarkable set of four 19th century monumental solid silver candlesticks, each standing 68 cm tall, was crafted by the distinguished German silversmith Franz Xavier Hellner (1819-1901). Hellner was one of the foremost Rhine-region masters of 19th-century historicist ecclesiastical silverwork, renowned for his skill in the neo-Gothic idiom and his workshop's production of liturgical and ceremonial objects. Executed with meticulous craftsmanship and a lustrous finish, the set reflects Hellner's mastery of form and decorative vocabulary, making them not merely functional objects but prestigious works of silver artistry. They would be particularly suited to a grand ecclesiastical setting, a formal interior ensemble, or a museum collection illustrating historicist
