Description

This pair of Dresden porcelain figure groups represents the allegorical seasons "Summer" and "Winter" from the Four Seasons series produced by Carl Thieme in Potschappel near Dresden, a factory renowned for decorative and luxury porcelain since its founding in 1872.

The figures are arranged on oval gilt-edged bases in refined cabinet-scale compositions, distinguished by expressive facial painting, careful modelling, and finely detailed seasonal accessories.

The harvest-themed "Summer" group retains its original sickle, an uncommon and highly desirable feature, while the "Winter" group depicts a folk-inspired rural scene with sledge, axe, and warming fire, dressed in traditional Eastern Slavic winter costume.
