Description

This large-format work by Victor Hasch is a mosaic of 20 mixed media techniques on canvas, forming a contemporary whole. The frame is made of black wood (in used condition). On the back, a label indicates that the work was previously exhibited at Galerie BEL-AIR FINE ART, a leading European gallery whose 26 galleries offer a selection of top-quality contemporary art. Dimensions: 156 x 144 cm (framed); 133.5 x 121.5 cm (sight size) Victor Hasch was a French painter and lithographer born in 1945 and died in 2012. Known for his vibrant colors, his work is in the tradition of the painters he admired: Andy Warhol, Jean-Michel Basquiat, Robert Rauschenberg, and Nicolas de Staël. In his later series, he even depicted his mentors in portraits. "Painting should transport you, and I
