



## Antique Silver-plated Metal Sugar Bowl, 19th-20th Century (1880-1930)

### Description

An elegant antique sugar bowl from the 19th-20th century, circa 1880-1930, made of silver-plated metal resting on a circular pedestal, with two stylish side handles and a pretty lid. The shape is balanced and classic, decorated with beaded friezes running along the body and base, typical of French production of the period. Hallmarks are visible under the base: "PT," a framed cat's head, a rather uncommon hallmark for antique French silversmithing. Approximately 17cm high with the lid, 16cm wide with the handles, maximum diameter approximately 10-11cm. In very good condition, with no silver plating loss, a patina from cleaning, fine micro-scratches on the surface, and a few discreet scratches from use; some black marks on the interior. Weighs just over 300g.
