Pair of Hunting Trophies, Pheasant and Duck, Late 19th Century, in the style of Jules Moigniez (1834-1895). Large pair of hunting trophies, representing game birds: a pheasant and a duck. Made of alloy and spelter, they are presented suspended from sunflower-shaped nails and are highly detailed, modeled after nature. The game birds themselves are presented on molded light oak bases. Very fine chasing finish; examine the details carefully. gilt and silver patina in places, possibly some loss of patina, but this adds to their antique charm. A few small dents are visible in the photos. Realistic work from life, dating from the late 19th century. A very beautiful pair of hunting trophies. Dimensions: 46 cm high x 36 cm wide.
