Description

Viking Age 800-900 AD. Pre-Christian gold pendant. This pendant features a motif evoking the Christian Trinity, illustrated with designs from Celtic pagan iconography. This piece testifies to the conversion to Christianity of the Viking world in the 9th century. Gold medallion surmounted by a tubular suspension ring. The field is decorated with tripartite filigree volutes radiating from a central medallion, the spaces between them filled with tight spirals. A corded filigree border runs along the perimeter.
