In the superb, characteristic Delft dark blue, a lakeside landscape is depicted with two boats, a flock of birds, and a border of flowers and symbols. Diameter: 35.5 cm. Very good condition. No cracks or repairs. Minor chips that do not detract from the quality of this dish. ("umbilicus": a rounded, central projection (of a shield, dish, plate, etc.) Dishes with central ridges were primarily used in the 16th and 17th centuries.")
