Impressed Nymphenburg mark in the form of a shield with the Bavarian coat of arms, as well as the model number 413 under the base. Model created by Joseph Wackerle (Artistic Director of the Nymphenburg Porcelain Manufactory in Munich until 1917). Excellent condition. Height 20 cm.

*NYMPHENBURG: Porcelain manufactory located in Nymphenburg Palace in Munich, Bavaria, founded in 1747 by Maximilian III Joseph of Bavaria.
