Description

A mother-of-pearl sewing kit in a mother-of-pearl case with a gilt bronze mount in the form of a piece of furniture. The frame, decorated with oak leaves and winged putti, rests on four claw feet.

This kit comes from the shops of the Palais Royal. The needle case bears its emblem: an enameled pansy on a medallion. The drawer opens to reveal a mother-of-pearl sewing kit on a removable tray. The kit includes: - A pair of mother-of-pearl scissors - A mother-of-pearl thimble - A needle case with the enameled pansy - A toothpick/ear pick - A hook holder (missing at the end) - A salt flask with a gold stopper (missing on the stopper) - A mother-of-pearl needle. The case measures 16.6 x 10.9 cm
