Subject: "Refugium agonizantium," Prefiguration of the death of Jesus - rare depiction of Joseph, protector of the dying and of the Holy Family, leaning over the Infant Jesus and decorated with a cartouche of floral garland. The painting features a large number of flowers such as roses and wild roses. Early Christians linked the wild rose to Christ's crown of thorns, the five petals symbolizing the five sufferings, and the flower generally became a symbol of Mary's chastity and the Immaculate Conception.
