Imari porcelain plate with cobalt blue decoration, circular in shape with a slightly scalloped, contoured rim. The central decoration depicts a fantastical animal, possibly a Buddhist lion, moving among stylized rocks at the foot of a flowering shrub with large peonies and foliage rendered in flat, nuanced areas. The lion dance originated from a custom associated with the celebration of the New Year during the Edo period. The rim is simple, highlighted by the undulating movement of the border.
