It includes: Tweezers that also serve as a file and toothpick A pair of scissors Two nesting handles onto which screw: A rounded blade A pointed blade A corkscrew An awl A two-pronged fork Four slots are empty of their instruments. The instruments screw securely onto the handles. The case is not hallmarked but has been tested with a touchstone. A superb case made of silver, whose brilliance accentuates its charm and preciousness. It is also a moving testament to the art of living in the 18th and 19th centuries. 9.7 cm high 4.8 cm wide 2 cm thick 113 grams gross Good condition, minor scratches and dents from use.
