A pretty English sterling silver case, probably originally intended for a cigarette holder. The case is made of plain silver, with a hinged lid topped by a loop. It can be worn as a pendant in a very contemporary style and could hold, for example, a small bottle of perfume. The case is hallmarked: Lion passant for English sterling silver, Chester city hallmark, Date letter M for the year 1895-96, Later French hallmark: swan. A charming little case that could be repurposed as a piece of jewelry or a very fashionable accessory. 9.1 cm high excluding the movable ring, 1.4 cm maximum diameter, 16.5 grams.
