The shaker is hallmarked: Minerva hallmark, first standard, pre-1973, for 950/1000 silver. Maker's mark: CC with a bee and three stars for Christofle et Compagnie, hallmark used between 1853 and 1935. A very beautiful little sugar shaker with a magnificent, elegant, and striking design.
