Their design testifies to the exceptional skill of the craftsman. The crystal body, elegantly shaped in a spiral, rises fluidly from the base to the neck. The perfect fusion of glass and silver creates a refined and delicate effect, resulting in perfectly balanced proportions and graceful contours. The slender, delicate handles complement the impeccably hinged lids, illustrating casting and polishing techniques of exceptional quality.
