Description

STEHLE ALOIS (1854-1952) Figure of an Egyptian Woman. Bronze with nuanced brown patina, signed on the base. This sculpture represents a female figure of Egyptian inspiration, rendered in a Neoclassical style marked by the Orientalist taste of the late 19th century. The artist, STEHLE ALOIS (1854-1952), develops a balanced composition here, where the rigor of the lines interacts with the softness of the modeling. The figure is depicted standing, in a hieratic pose reminiscent of the canons of Antiquity. The structured hairstyle with vertical locks, held in place by a headband, as well as the stylized necklace and arm bracelets, clearly situate the work within the Egyptianizing movement then very popular in the decorative arts. The anatomical treatment, however, remains

naturalistic, with particular attention paid to volumes and the subtle tension of the lines. With arms slightly outstretched and one hand palm up, the sculpture possesses a presence that is both calm and solemn. The subtly nuanced brown patina highlights the quality of the casting and emphasizes the details of the face as well as the delicate transitions in the modeling. The circular base, with its stylized decoration, ensures stability and harmony. The signature "Stehle Alois" is visible on the base. This work is firmly rooted in the tradition of decorative bronzes of the Belle Époque, reflecting the fascination with Antiquity and the artistic Egyptomania that profoundly influenced European sculpture.
