Superb dessert flatware by the renowned silversmiths Cardeilhac and Christofle. The Brienne pattern is richly decorated with scrolls, florets, palmettes, and other motifs in the Empire style. Each piece is hallmarked: Minerva 1st standard mark (pre-1973) for 950/1000 silver Christofle silversmith's mark OC with a bee and three stars (since 1935) Cardeilhac silversmith's mark with a crowned Legion of Honor surmounting a crescent moon. The Cardeilhac company was acquired by Christofle in 1951, which explains the presence of these two hallmarks on the same piece. Beautiful flatware, in a classic and richly decorated design by Cardeilhac & Christofle. Each piece is heavy and finely crafted, a testament to the renowned quality of the most celebrated French
