Description

Watercolor and ink on paper, circa 1920. An elegant drawing attributed to Jules Pascin, executed in ink and watercolor on paper around 1920. The scene, remarkably spontaneous, depicts a group of figures seated at a table in a café or meeting place, a recurring theme for the artist. It displays all the lightness of Pascin's characteristic line: a supple, nervous, almost vibrant line that suggests more than it describes, capturing the moment with remarkable economy of means. The composition breathes, the figures sketched with controlled freedom, revealing the suspended elegance so characteristic of his work. The watercolor subtly highlights certain areas, adding depth and nuance without weighing down the scene. The drawing measures 23.3 × 29.3 cm. With its frame, it reaches 46.2 × 52.3 cm, a
