### Description

A covered jam or sugar jar from the Art Nouveau period, early 20th century. The object is designed to resemble an apple, with a smooth, rounded base surmounted by a small stem like an apple's stalk. The upper part, resembling the apple's skin, is made of gilt bronze with a slightly granular texture, imitating the texture of apple skin. The base is T-shaped with finely sculpted leaves, made of silvered metal, with naturalistic details.
