Decorative Floral Mosaic Plaque, Circa 1900

This charming polychrome mosaic wall plaque features a stylized floral design, composed of tesserae forming four pinkish-red flowers with sinuous green stems against a luminous gold background. The composition is set within a trilobed ogival shape, evoking the aesthetics of stained glass and medieval inspiration reinterpreted by Art Nouveau. The design, animated by a supple and balanced vegetal rhythm, perfectly illustrates the Belle Époque's taste for organic lines and the decorative stylization of the plant world. Made of carefully fitted glass or glazed ceramic tesserae, the mosaic presents a vibrant surface that captures the light thanks to its gold background, giving the piece a particularly refined decorative presence.
