A beautiful Aubusson wool tapestry, entitled "Bord de l'eau" (Water's Edge), published by the Parisian firm Robert Four, 41 rue de Richelieu, Paris. This horizontal composition depicts elegant greenery enlivened by birds, in the spirit of the grand decorative designs of the 17th century. The refined decoration of abundant vegetation, a river, and stylized birds is in the tradition of classical French tapestries. A mid-20th-century (circa 1950-1970) Aubusson workshop piece, woven on a low-warp loom. The reverse shows the characteristics of a hand-woven workshop tapestry.
