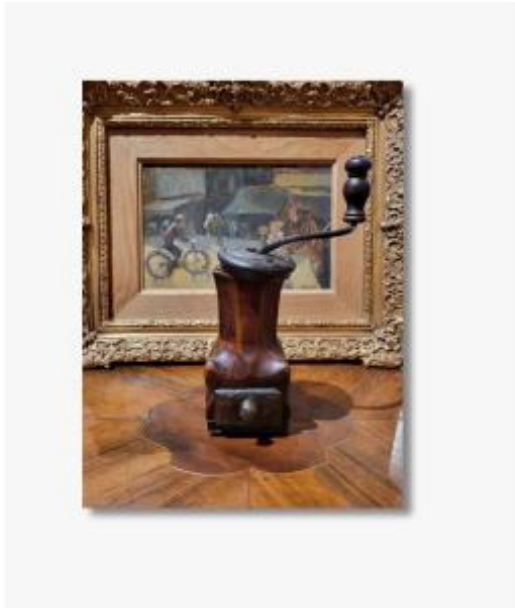




An 18th-century Mill At Poudre

Made of wood with intricately carved shapes. The upper part of the mill, adorned with a large wooden flywheel, is the central element, grinding peppercorns via an internal screw mechanism.

The mill's body is slightly flared, giving it an elegant and balanced form. The small box at the bottom of the mill, visible next to the base, likely serves to collect the ground pepper. The woodwork is exquisite, offering a smooth texture and a glossy finish that testifies to the skill of 18th-century artisans.
